Ten of Webber's 11 participants successfully placed for the State competition. As the college division of Future Business Leaders of America – Phi Beta Lambda, PBL's competitive events test student knowledge, through examination and other objective demonstration of skills, in a variety of business and career related areas. Webber's PBL is sponsored by Business Department Chair and Professor of Finance Dr. Jeanette Eberle.
