

FLAG DESIGN CONTEST!



On behalf of the City, the Lake Wales Arts Council will accept submissions in person, electronically or through the US mail beginning November 13 through January 2, 2018.

ALL DESIGNS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- Artist must be a Lake Wales resident, design professional or a student attending an elementary, middle, or high school located in the community of Lake Wales. Student Worksheets Submission forms will be available for download at www.cityoflakewales.org or www.lakewalesartscouncil.com.
- Only one entry per person or firm.
- Entry may be submitted in any art medium and should be no larger than 11" x 17" and no smaller than 5" x 7". *Artists should realize that the winning design must be turned into a digital picture to make the flag. Therefore, designs might be slightly altered in the process.*
- Images, colors, or patterns should relate to what is symbolized.
- Limit the number of colors on the flag to three, which contrast well and come from the standard color set.
- No writing of any kind or any seal other than that of the City can be included.
- Avoid duplicating other flags.
- The winning design will become the property of the City of Lake Wales.
- Entries must include Name, Company (if applicable), Phone, Email, Mailing Address, Grade Level (if applicable), Description of flag design and explanation of design elements.
- Entries **will not** be accepted if they use the following: gradient color, two sides, designs that are plagiarized or are not completely original artwork.

The flag designs with the most votes in each category will be announced at the Citizen's Bank Lake Wales Arts Festival on Saturday, February 24, 2018 at 10 AM.

Winners in each student category will receive a monetary prize. One of them will be selected by the City of Lake Wales as the design to be produced and fly over the City. The winning designer will be presented a check for **\$500**
