

## **Tournament Rules**

1. Life vests/life jackets will be worn and secured by all persons anytime their boat is on a plane.
2. All boats must be checked by someone associated with the tournament at the ramp.
3. 5 fish limit per boat (12" minimum), largemouth bass, closed mouth, pinched tail, on golden rule. \*Black Bass Permits will be given at check in.
4. All fish must be released alive, no culling of dead fish, a .25 pound penalty per dead fish will be imposed on total weight.
5. Any team observed not following guidelines from rule #4 will be disqualified.
6. Teams presenting a short fish at weigh in will lose their big bass with the option to prove length of fish. There will be no courtesy checks.
7. Decisions of tournament director are final.
8. No angler may leave boat during tournament hours, except for emergencies, such as bad weather, medical or restroom.
9. No alcoholic beverages or drugs during tournament hours.
10. No gas motor trolling.
11. Fish is not permitted within fifty yards of any anchored boat with trolling motor up.
12. Only one rod per person may be used at any given time, artificial bait only.
13. Take-off and weigh in order determined by drawing.
14. During weigh in, boaters will bring fish to scale location. Boater takes responsibility for release of fish.
15. All boats must have aerated live wells.
16. All boaters will sign a Release of Liability form when paying entry fee.
17. Late boats not within designated area will be penalized one pound per minute up to five minutes and then be disqualified.
18. In event of boat failure at least one contestant with fish kept separate may be transported to weigh in by another boat. No fishing allowed after picking up another competitor.
19. Any protests involving rules violation must be presented to tournament director in written form within 15 minutes of tournament's end.

**Entry fee will be \$50 per boat and big bass optional \$10 per boat.**

**Payback will be for first three places with guaranteed \$1,000 additional for first place. Splits will be 60% for first, 25% for second and 15% on third. Big bass payback is 100% of big bass pot.**
