Virginia Lassiter Leadership Luncheon

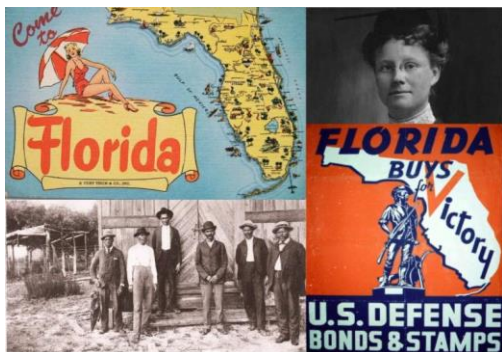

This luncheon honors the late Virginia Lassiter's lifelong dedication to the Lake Wales Public Library. As one of the founders of the Lake Wales Library Association in 1954, Jita spearheaded the effort to provide publicly funded library services to residents of Lake Wales.

The 2018 Virginia Lassiter Leadership Luncheon will feature a panel discussion with three local leaders in Lake Wales' agri-business field, Ellis Hunt, Jr., Cary Lightsey and Emil Jahna, Jr. The three Lake Walesans will discuss the history and economic impact of their businesses on our city. The Lake Wales Public Library & Polk County Library Cooperative's Bookmobile and BMail services will celebrate National Library Week, April 8 - 14.

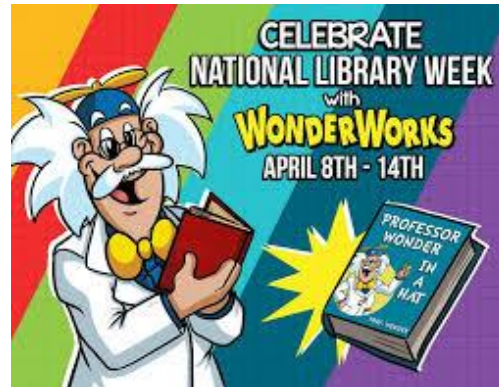
National Library Week is a celebration of libraries of all types and the services they perform for everyone.

The Lake Wales Public Library is honored to operate the mobile branch library service, Polk Co. Library Cooperative Bookmobile.

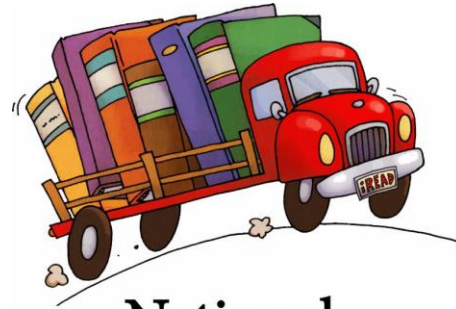
