


What's Happening at the LAKE WALES MUSEUM DECEMBER 2018



Visit our new historical exhibit about one community's preservation, perseverance, and philanthropy, opening on Tuesday, December 4, 2018.

This is the the story of Mountain Lake Estates, one of the oldest private golf and estate communities in the country, located in Lake Wales, Florida.

The exhibit will feature stories, photographs and original documents that highlight the development of Mountain Lake, stories about its founder, Frederick Ruth, the lifestyle of its residents and members, philanthropic contributions to the community, and the preservation of century old homes and architectural designs. Artifacts on display are on loan from the Mountain Lake archives, and items from the museum's permanent collection. The exhibit was developed by the museum's curator, Bartholomew Delcamp and director, Jennifer D'hollander.


