Mobile Voter Registration Coming To Davenport and Frostproof

POLK COUNTY, FL (February 13, 2019) – Municipal Election Day is April 2nd, and the Polk County Election Team will be on the road to offer residents a chance to register to vote by the March 4th registration deadline. Residents who are not currently registered to vote in Polk County are encouraged to stop by and complete a voter registration application. “We want to make sure that every person has the opportunity to have their voice heard,” said Supervisor of Elections, Lori Edwards.

The Election Team will be in the City of Davenport and the City of Frostproof, where they will provide on-site voter registration services on the following dates:

- **DAVENPORT:** Saturday, February 16th from 10 am – 5 pm, at the Grills Gone Wild event, 110 West Bay St
- **FROSTPROOF:** Saturday, February 16th, from 9 am – 3 pm, at the Orange Blossom Festival, 12 E Wall St

Once a voter has registered to vote, there is no need to register again. However, registered voters may stop by the mobile registration sites to update their name, address, party, or signature.
