RE: National Preservation Week Book Repair Class

Preservation Week is sponsored by the American Library Association and inspires actions to preserve personal, family and community collections as well as collections in libraries, museums and archives.

In celebration of Preservation Week the Lake Wales Public Library will host our *Basic Book Repair Class*. The class begins at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, April 23 in the library's Schoenoff Meeting Room.

The 90-minute class will include an overview of the parts of a book, the difference between preservation, restoration and conservation. Participants will learn how to properly repair torn pages and broken spines. They will understand the tools needed to repair a book correctly.

This class is free, is but limited to 10 people. Registration is *required*. Registered participants should bring one personal example of a book in need of repair.
