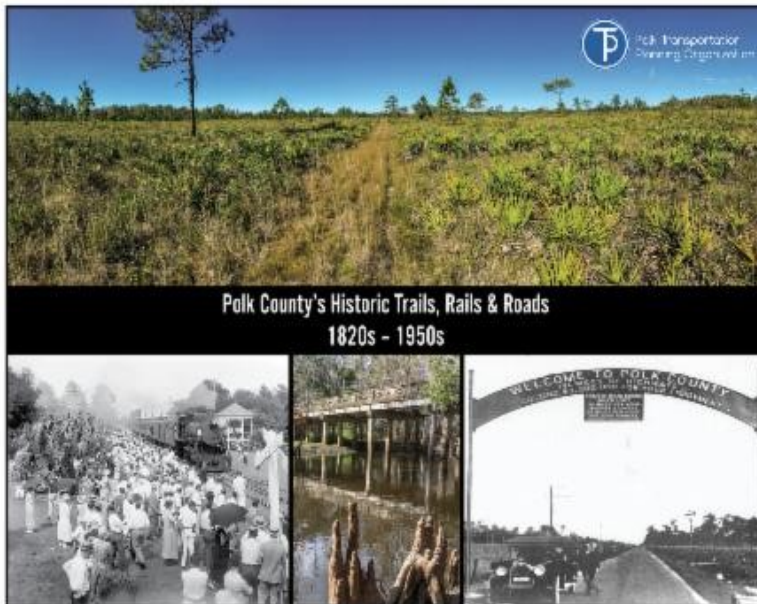


# POLK COUNTY HISTORY CENTER CROSSROADS LECTURE SERIES MARCH 2019
